SAFETY AND DRIVING PRECAUTIONS

We still receive reports of speeding throughout the community. The speed limit posted is not a suggestion, it is the law. Please do not exceed the posted limits. We have a large number of regular walkers as well as residents walking their dogs. Please help to keep our community safe.

PARKING

Woodside Trails has limited parking outside of our drive ways. The St Louis county designed streets are only 25ft wide for which the city of Ballwin allows parking on only one side of the street designated by posted signs. There is no parking around the cul-de-sacs. Additional parking is available in the commercial lot by the tennis court.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Summer is here. Remember to adjust your thermostat so it does not constantly run during the summer temperatures. Closing blinds also helps to keep the heat out. Don't forget to change your filter.

CLUBHOUSE

ARCHITECTURAL CONTROLS REMINDERS

The Board of Directors reminds everyone that any alteration to the exterior of the building, common grounds, or limited common elements *requires prior approval from the Board.*

This requirement exists to ensure the community consistency and pleasing exterior appearance is properly maintained. No owner or other party may make alterations to the exterior of the property without oversight and consideration of the impact that such an alteration could have. This also applies to placing items outside of our doorways and halls for Garden building owners.

To seek approval for an alteration or improvement, please file an Architectural Request and submit to AMC Management, LLC. Once submitted, the Community Manager will review the request prior to forwarding to the Board for review. Once the Board has reached a decision that decision will be communicated to the requester in short order, via an approval or denial letter sent by mail. Forms can be found at www.woodsidetrails.com. Paper forms are also available at the clubhouse inside the side entry door. Your pool key will open this door. Your cooperation is necessary and greatly appreciated!

TRASH SERVICES AND REMINDERS

Large appliances, electronics, furniture, etc. will be removed on the last Thursday of the month. You *must* contact Waste Connections (636-321-2100) prior to placing these items out for pick up. Removal of bulk items must be scheduled beforehand.
